## Community Profile

---

The community of Lambertson is made up of 800 people located in Redwood County in Southwest Minnesota. Lambertson has strong agricultural roots. The Lambertson community boasts a variety of retail shops including a grocery store, businesses and amenities.

There are multiple professional businesses including banking, insurance, and real estate services. Service businesses include plumbing and heating, electricians, and mechanics. Hospitality businesses include two restaurant/bars and a motel.

The City Park includes picnic shelters, playgrounds, volleyball, basketball and pickleball courts. Kuhar Park located just north of town provides RV and camping sites. The city operates an outdoor swimming pool during the summer months. The Lambertson Library offers many services and has additional programming for children and adults.

The City of Lambertson also has a police department, ambulance service, a fire department and a local newspaper. Although Lambertson is considered a small town, it has all the essential services and businesses located here.

## Business Highlights

---

### Meadowland Farmers Coop

Started in 1905, the farmer owned coop provides 185 jobs to the region they serve. Meadowland purchases grain from farmers in the area along with providing livestock feed services. Lambertson is home of the coop's corporate offices.

### Highwater Ethanol

Located just outside of Lambertson's city limits, Highwater Ethanol was built in 2009. This 50 million gallon ethanol plant had sales of just over \$159 million in 2021.

### Elevator Works

Elevator Works started in 1999 just north of town filling the need for a large scale agricultural equipment construction and repair company. Much of the parts needed for their repair and construction jobs are fabricated in their state of the art shop.

## Transportation Resources

---

### US Hwy 14 & US Hwy 71

US Hwy 14 & 71 are two of the longest highways in the US. Lambertson is located along US Highway 14 and just 7 miles west of US Highway 71. Connecting Lambertson to the North, South, East and West borders of the United States.

### Rail Line

Lambertson is located along the Canadian Pacific Rail Line which is connected to the nationwide rail network. Two large industries in the Lambertson area have installed rail spurs. These rail spurs have improved safety and loading conditions for shipping commodities from Lambertson.

## Educational Assests

---

### Red Rock Central

Red Rock Central is the K-12 school located in Lambertson that serves the communities of Lambertson, Sanborn, Storden and Jeffers. RRC has received national recognition for the quality education provided and student achievements. The new K-12 school building opened in October 2024.

### Southwest Research & Outreach Center

As part of the University of Minnesota's College of Food, Agriculture and Natural Resource Science. The work done at Lambertson's SWROC enhances the quality of agricultural production, human health, renewable energy and the environment, and disseminates the benefits of this research to the public.
