ORDINANCE NUMBER 69

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT
REVOLVING FUND

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAMBERTON, REDWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby created and established for the Village
of Lumberton, a permanent improvement revolving fund for the purposes of
advancing moneys necessary to provide funds for the making of any permanent
improvements in the Village. Said fund shall be a permanent fund of the
Village and shall be supported by taxation. Into said fund shall be paid all
moneys received from the issuance of any permanent improvement revolving fund
bonds, all moneys received from the payments of assessments levied for any im-
provements which were financed in the first instance from this fund and all moneys
received from taxes levied or transferred from other funds for the support of the
permanent improvement revolving fund.

Section 2. The permanent improvement revolving fund shall be kept by
the village treasurer as a special separate fund apart from all other funds
and accounts of the Village and the moneys therein shall be used for no other
purposes except as herein stated, provided that when and as there shall be moneys
therein not needed for permanent improvement by the Village Council may invest
such moneys in bonds legal for investment by municipal sinking funds in this state.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage and publication.
