Re: Water Service Lines

Dear Property Owner,

You are receiving this notice because a portion of your water service line is made of unacceptable material or the material is currently unknown.

Each property's water service line has two sections:

- City-Owned Portion: The line that runs from the city's main water line to the curb stop.
- Property Owner Portion: The line that runs from the curb stop to your home's water meter.

Enclosed you will find information required by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) based on what is currently known about the water service line materials for your property.

The City of Lambertson previously received grant funding to replace all identified lead service lines—both city-owned and privately-owned—with approved materials. Those replacements have been completed.

You may have a lead service line, but the city portion is unknown. Because of this, your line was not replaced with this last round of grant funding. We need to find out what the city side is before any changes can be made.

At this time, there are still a number of service lines with “unknown” materials, particularly on the city-owned portion. This is due to limited historical records of what materials were installed or replaced during past street and utility projects. The city is currently working to identify these unknown lines.

Once all materials are verified, a plan will be developed to replace any remaining lines that require it. The city will continue to pursue available grant opportunities to complete this work at no cost to property owners. However, there is no set timeline for these activities yet. Some replacements may be incorporated in street projects if possible.

There is no action required from property owners at this time. Please review the enclosed information from the Minnesota Department of Health and contact the city office if you have any questions.
